EQUIPPING THE FORCE WITH DATA AND TECH

Data, Al algorithms, and supercomputers are technologies you may hear about in the news often, but did you know they are critical weapons in the fight against human trafficking? These tools give us a unique advantage over traffickers. Initially, when we started DeliverFund, we had only one laptop, and our CEO manually collected all the data. However, today, thanks to the generosity of DeliverFund's donors and the ingenuity of the DeliverFund team, we have two supercomputers running algorithms that collect more data in an hour than we collected in the first five years of our operations. This enormous amount of data allows us to not only find traffickers faster but also control our costs and invest in the sustainability of our mission. In short, we are now able to find traffickers and facilitate law enforcement operations better, faster, and more efficiently than ever before.

Data is the fuel that powers the counter-human trafficking engine, and this year, we boosted our collection efforts significantly, resulting in a 467% increase in data collection and processing. Previously, human traffickers could advertise their victims online, and once their victims were booked for the day, they would remove those advertisements before they could be detected. But that is not the case anymore. Our collectors at DeliverFund are running at a rate that makes it nearly impossible for the traffickers to avoid detection.

So how do we do it? (Tech-speak warning!) At DeliverFund, we use a custom, redundant, in-house High-Performance Computing (HPC) framework optimized for the daily scouring of tens of thousands of web properties to collect vast amounts of data that can be used to detect human trafficking. We use advanced algorithms, real-time data processing, and NoSQL databases like OpenSearch to manage over 4 billion unique, fully versioned data points. By using cutting-edge technology, including AI, we're committed to fighting human trafficking and providing critical insights to first responders.

In short, Al has dramatically shaped how we've approached technology at DeliverFund, and we are using the latest Al technologies as weapons against human traffickers.

REDLIGHT DATA

Our Redlight dataset currently consists of millions of online advertisements where human trafficking victims are advertised.

With our improved hardware, we are able to collect millions of new advertisements weekly. Gain access to this information with the HT Safeguard app.

HT WATCHLIST

The Human Trafficking Watchlist is the only data repository in existence that assists users in proactively identifying persons known or suspected to be involved with human trafficking.

Having access to this data is particularly crucial for our law enforcement partners in order to develop successful investigations.

ONLINE TRAINING

We are creating a series of new digital training tools for law enforcement, parents and guardians, and the general public to disperse the knowledge we have collected over years of fighting human trafficking.

TRAINING LAW ENFORCEMENT AT SCALE

DeliverFund's commitment to eradicating human trafficking still stretches beyond technology; it's also about empowering law enforcement and prosecutors with the knowledge and tools to be more effective in the fight. Our innovative in-person training programs for law enforcement have quickly become the industry standard, but they are still limited by the officers who can attend in the location where they are held. Between the vast geography of the US and the shift work required by police officers, we were not reaching everyone we needed to.

Now, thanks to the generosity of our donors, we have been able to scale our most essential training to an infinite number of law enforcement officers by making it available online.

This isn't just about awareness; it's about fostering a community of vigilant individuals. With your support, we're building a network of law enforcement officers armed with knowledge and fortified against trafficking threats.

DeliverFund is survivor-informed and uses data to do our part in the fight against human trafficking. For far too long, human trafficking victims have been viewed as criminals and further traumatized by the criminal justice system. Survivors of human trafficking have more to offer than just a re-telling of their trauma. DeliverFund offers victim-centric training to our partners. Survivors can draw from their lived experience to inform investigations and develop programs for people in law enforcement, health care, mental health care service providers, and more.

EDUCATING THE PUBLIC

DeliverFund has always worked to educate the public about the realities of Human Trafficking through our websites and social media accounts, but we realized we needed to do more to help people learn the realities of human trafficking and learn to dispel myths surrounding the issue. This last year, we launched the first of our online training programs designed to educate the public as to what human trafficking is and what they can do about it in their community. Starting with our **Human Trafficking 101** course, DeliverFund's training curriculums will expand into multiple areas, helping everyone become part of the army that fights human trafficking.

The online training programs, produced by donor generosity, empowers individuals with the knowledge to identify and report potential trafficking situations, acting as a first line of defense in their communities. The training also fosters a proactive environment, where community members are more vigilant and responsive to the signs of trafficking, thereby potentially saving lives and preventing exploitation. Moreover, it helps dispel myths and stereotypes about victims, promoting a more accurate understanding of the diverse backgrounds and circumstances of those affected.

HT SAFEGUARD

How do you screen for human trafficking in a definitive way?

After engaging in the fight for over ten years, we know firsthand how hard it is, and that is why we created **HT Safeguard**.

Thanks to donor generosity, for the first time in history, anyone can easily and safely search a phone number or email address to see if they are associated with potential human trafficking activity.

Almost all human trafficking investigations start by searching to see if a phone number or email address is **linked to a commercial sex advertisement**. Confirming that contact information is linked to a commercial sex advertisement does not mean the owner of that contact information is a human trafficker, but it does mean that contact information is, or was at one time, linked to potential human trafficking information. While you can find this out in a few minutes by doing a customized Google search, that search will take you to a pornographic website where you can be exposed to graphic pictures and videos.

You and your children who have smartphones needed a better way to screen contact information for potential connections to human trafficking, so we built **HT Safeguard**. And we are just getting started with our efforts to empower public detection and the reporting of human trafficking activity.


